Objectives - After attending this program you should be able to:

1. Apply a step by step pragmatic structure to support couples in a transformative relational process.
2. Recognize the difference in a couples exchange between the adaptive “survival dance” and the “dance of life in connection.”
3. Practice rituals and skills in becoming “bilingual” and learning the distinctive vocabulary of the “other.”
4. Utilize practical well delineated techniques for growing attention span, focus, concentration and presence to the “other.”
5. Describe the four theoretical pillars at the base of Encounter-centered Couples Therapy.
6. Recognize the difference in a couples exchange between the “dialogical domain” and the “domain of the encounter.”
7. Assess the climate in the “space between” as a way for the Couples Therapist to assist a couple in creating a safe haven rather than a war zone or a desert, and learn about the essential elements that nurture the “Relational Space” of couples.
8. Observe live demonstrations of relational work with couples and distinguish each of the steps involved in a Visit Over the Bridge.
9. Demonstrate how to dissolve frustrations in a relationship through the Visit Over the Bridge process.
10. Distinguish the difference between the Language of Deficit and the Language of Abundance.
11. Gain a deeper understanding of how to shift couples from blame to cooperation.
12. Describe the natural capacities of the relational brain for deep wordless empathic connection, called in the new neuroscience the “brain-bridge.”
13. Practice the art of rhythm and pacing based on true emotional integration and mutual emotional regulation for the couple.
14. Demonstrate their understanding of the therapeutic distinction between stepping into content (Words and Themes) and guiding a process (Energy and Space).
15. Show an understanding of the therapeutic distinction between attempting to solve the couple’s conflict as an obstacle to the relationship versus introducing conflict as a launching pad for emotional and relational growth.
16. Illustrate the use of the metaphor of “neighborhoods” especially those of the “precious neighborhoods” as well as the “tough neighborhoods.”
